Alexander Valley Vineyards has fashioned one of the finest dry roses I have tasted from California. Their 2008 Dry Rose of Sangiovese is similar to a French Tavel, offering notes of watermelons, strawberries, and cherries, medium body, plenty of character, and a dry finish. Enjoy it over the next 8-10 months. **88 Points**



The two Zinfandels are meant to be consumed over the near term. The 2006 Zinfandel Temptation (which includes some Sangiovese) is an elegant, berry, earthy, peppery style of Zinfandel with round, easy-going flavors, medium body, and the alcohol well in check. **86 Points**



The 2006 Zinfandel Redemption exhibits a darker ruby color, more depth, plenty of currant, plum, licorice, and pepper characteristics, and a meaty, medium to full-bodied texture. **87 Points**

Another top value, the 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon offers spicy, cedary, black currant notes intermixed with hints of roasted herbs and smoke. Medium-bodied with excellent fruit, good purity, and an adequate finish, it can be drunk over the next 2-3 years. **87 Points**
